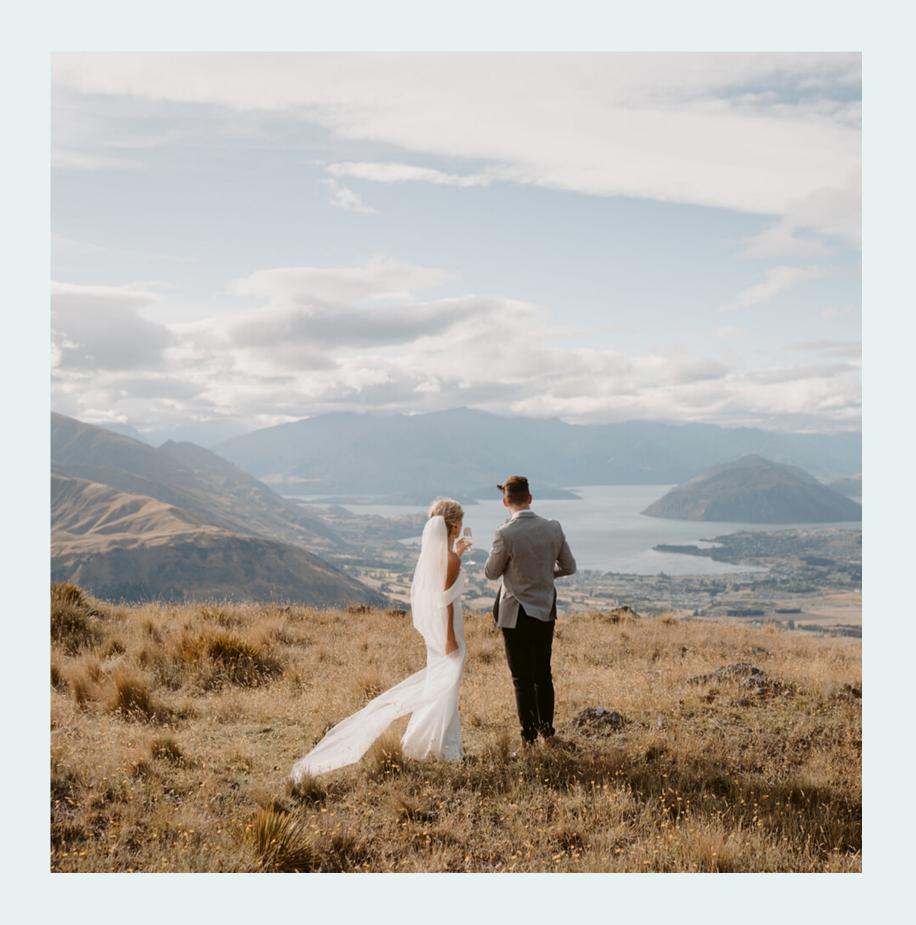
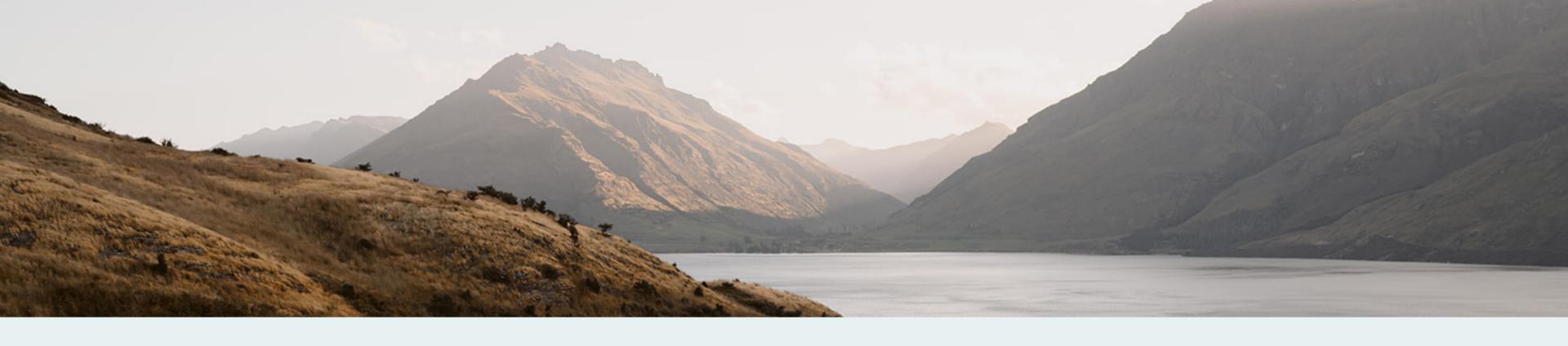


WHAT IS THE QUEENSTOWN WEDDING ASSOCIATION?

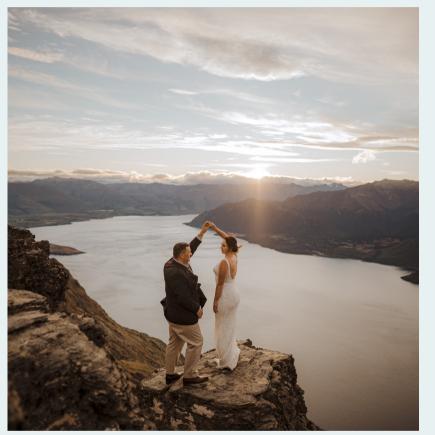
WHO CAN JOIN THE QWA?

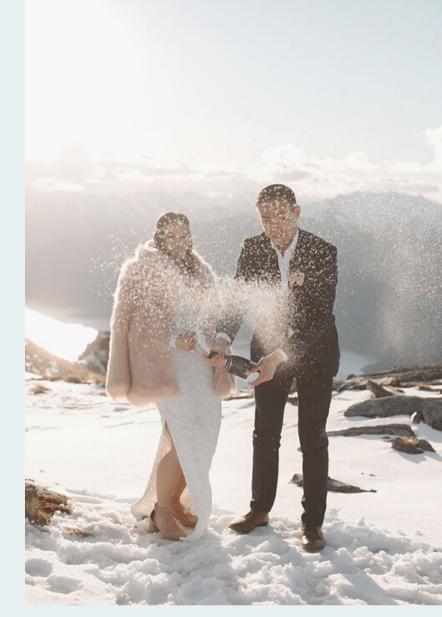

This includes but is not limited to, businesses in Queenstown, Arrowtown, Glenorchy, Kingston, Cromwell, Wanaka, Hawea, Alexandra and Clyde.

Edit and update your own listing any time you like with your personal login details. We encourage all QWA members to keep their listings relevant and up to date.



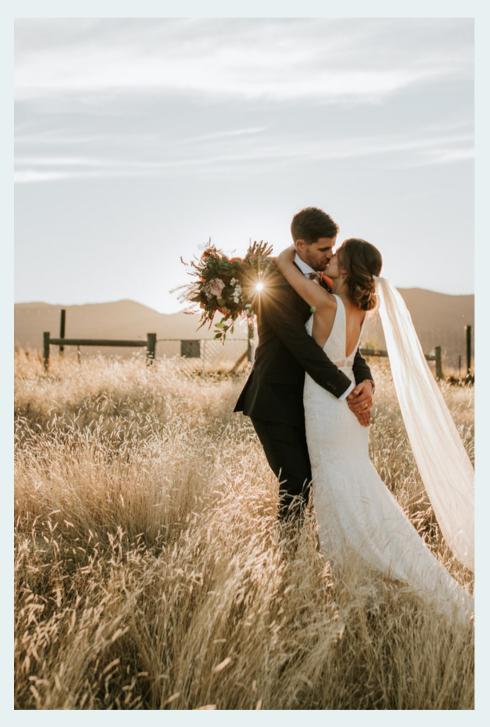






- O2. Exclusive access to QWA networking events free of charge to meet and make connections with other wedding industry professionals.

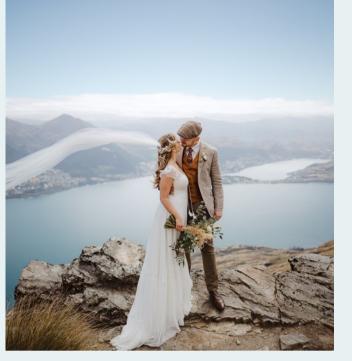
- O4. Exclusive opportunities for your work to be shared on the QWA social media channels via Instagram, Facebook and Pinterest
- Opportunities for you to sponsor QWA events and show off your products and services to fellow wedding industry professionals.















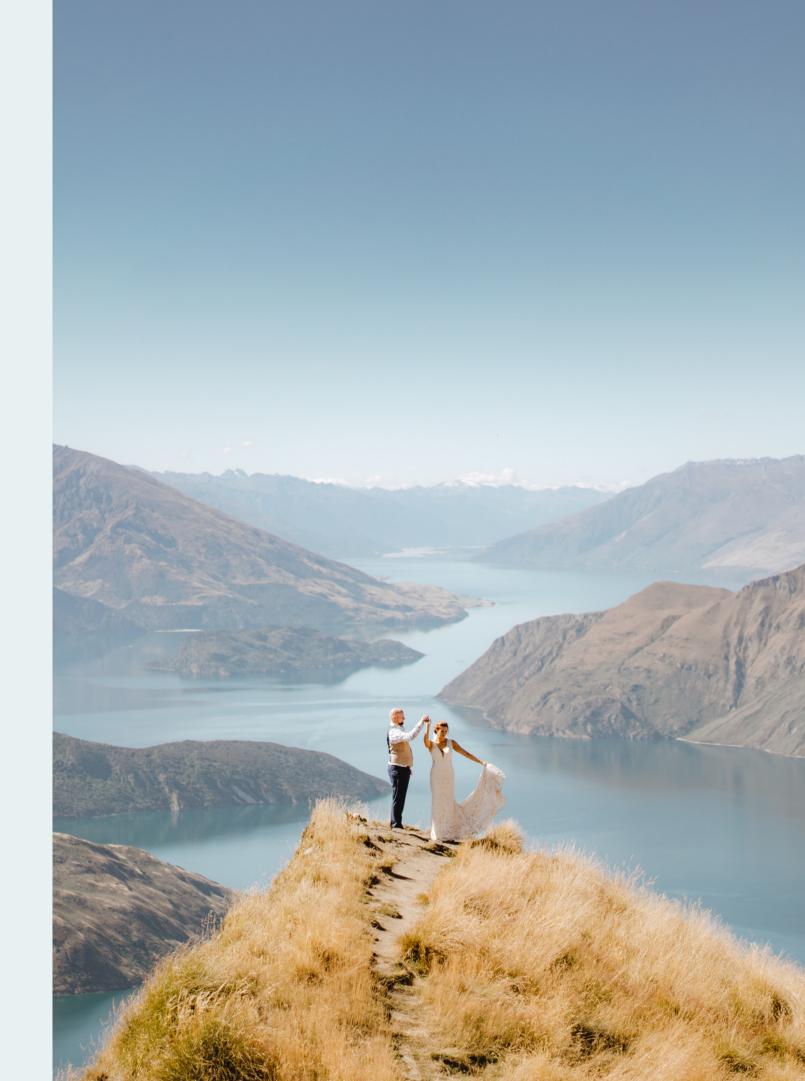
